#### 1. Venue:

### 2. Registration

- The registration desk will open at 8.15am on both days of the event and will be manned by the conference secretariat throughout the event.
- Identification tags, certificates and proceedings CD-ROM will only be issued once full payment has been made.
- Participants who registered under the student category may be asked to show their Student ID cards.

#### 3. Oral Presentation Sessions

- Papers in the same session will be presented in the sequence shown in the schedule without any breaks in between.
- Presenters will be given **20 minutes** to deliver their presentations. A minimum of 5 minutes must be allocated for Q&A or discussion at the end of their presentations.
- Any swapping of slots, even if mutually agreed between presenters, must be approved by the secretariat.

#### 4. Poster Presentation Session

- Posters must be submitted to the secretariat <u>before 9.00am</u> on the first day of the event.
- The poster viewing and Q&A session is between 3.30 pm and 4.30 pm on Day 1. During this period, presenters are required to be beside their respective posters to answer questions or receive comments from the audience.

### 5. Coffee Breaks and Lunch

- Refreshments will be served near the conference hall during the break times shown according to the schedule.
- Lunch will be served at the hotel restaurant. Participants will be required to show their conference identification tags at the entrance.

#### 6. Session Chairs
