2. Registration

- The registration desk will be manned by the conference secretariat throughout both days of the event.
- Participants can choose to sign in and collect their conference kits on either day.
- The registration desk will commence operations at 8.30am on both days of the event.
- The conference kit (including ID tags, certificates and proceedings CD-ROM) can only be collected if full payment has been made.
- Participants who have registered under the student category may be asked to show their original Student ID cards before collecting their conference kits.

- Lunch will be served at the hotel restaurant. Participants are required to display their conference identification tags in order to be seated.
